# <u>CITY OF ASHEVILLE NOISE ORDINANCE UPDATE</u>

In March 2019, the City of Asheville undertook the process of updating its municipal noise ordinance. Between March and August 2019, City staff engaged residents, business owners, industrial and institutional operators to identify and prioritize noise concerns and discuss practical solutions. To date, this engagement has included:

- 24 stakeholder meetings and forums
- 1,490 digital and paper survey responses
- 150+ NoiseScore smartphone app "noise reviews"
